Cockroaches: Preparing for Treatment







The Cockroach 🗯

On average, a mature cockroach can grow up to 4 cm in length (1.6"). The image above is not to scale.

Preparation is Required

A pest management company has been hired to treat for cockroaches in your unit. To make sure the treatment works well, it is important that you prepare your unit before the appointment.

Call LMCH immediately if you need help preparing your unit for treatment. If you do not do everything on the checklist, or you refuse to let the pest technicians in, LMCH could charge you for the cost of the visit.

IMPORTANT: For your safety, you will need to leave your unit for <u>at least</u> six (6) hours once treatment begins.



Preparation Checklist

Cockroaches can live in personal belongings such as electronics, books, cardboard boxes, etc. The pest management company is not responsible for handling or treating these items.

BEFORE TREATMENT DAY:

Empty all kitchen cupboards of all dishes, food containers and packaging

Remove old shelf paper

- Wash all cabinet surfaces with soap and hot water
- Empty and remove kitchen drawers
- Clear countertop and empty kitchen sink
- Empty bathroom vanity cupboard and wash surfaces with soap and hot water

ON TREATMENT DAY:

- Remove all pets (cat carriers available from LMCH)
- Cover fish tank, disconnect filter and unplug aerator

AFTER TREATMENT DAY:

Do not wash shelves or baseboards for at least four (4) weeks after the treatment because the pesticides are still working
